Hackney Homes turns off noisy tenant

Hackney Homes successfully prosecuted a tenant who was found guilty of disturbing neighbours with loud music at all times of the day.

Following reports from neighbours, Hackney Homes carried out investigations and the tenant was taken to court, fined £75 for each offence, ordered to pay costs of £648 and a victim surcharge of £15.

Majority of nuisance reported to Hackney Homes are related to noise.

Neehara Wijeyesekera, Head of Tenancy and Leasehold Services said: "Noise nuisance can seriously affect the quality of life of residents. That is why Hackney Homes takes all cases very seriously and persistent offenders will not be tolerated.
