Need an estate parking permit? Come to any Neighbourhood Housing office

Hackney Homes residents can now go to any of the eight neighbourhood housing offices to apply for an estate parking permit. This was following feedback from residents about how we can improve the services at a local level.

Neehara Wijeyesekera, Head of Tenancy and Leasehold Services said: "Following the resounding thumbs up from residents for Hackney Homes to manage neighbourhood housing services, we are focused on making improvements and this is one of many that residents have asked for".

To apply for a parking permit, you'll need the full Log Book for your vehicle, a valid MOT and a full Insurance Certificate. You will also need to ensure that your rent or service charges are up-to-date.
