Residents help secure injunction on noisy resident

A Shoreditch resident has been reprimanded with a court injunction following complaints from neighbours to Hackney Homes about drunk and disorderly behaviour.

Hackney Homes' Anti-Social Behaviour Officers had received reports of racist remarks and noise disturbances. They worked with residents to keep a log of the disturbances and visited the resident to make them aware of the problem.

Wayne Hylton, Head of Estate Safety said: "We are grateful for the support of our residents in bringing about this injunction. We are committed to tackling all nuisance and we urge residents to continue to report these to us".
